For various reasons it has taken much longer to finalise our race calendar this year but now it's done, and is one of our best ever. So, Donington being unavailable we start at Silverstone on the National circuit, but the big news is we are on the Grand prix circuit in May.

Race Retro Show, Stoneleigh Park Friday-Sunday 12-14 March. We will have a large stand in Hall 2, Stand D36, so please call and say hello, it's a good meeting point for members.

Silverstone Sunday 28 March. Season opener. Races for all our championships except DBT (as many of the cars are not back from Australia). Special note: CF3 will have a double header. Cadwell Park Sunday 11 April. All championship races except DBT and Guards. Two races for FJ one front engined, one rear engined. Special note: double header races for Touring cars and CRC and an invitation race for FF2000. Entry forms are published. Testing available Friday 9 April, details on [www.motorsportvision.co.uk](http://www.motorsportvision.co.uk)

Hockenheim, Germany Friday-Sunday 16-18 April. First race for our Historic Formula Two championship. Entry forms published shortly.

Silverstone Saturday/Sunday 15-16 May. For our International Trophy meeting the big news as stated above is that we will be racing on the Grand Prix circuit on both days. This is a wonderful opportunity for members as the chances to race on this track are very few and it's a privilege for the club to organise. All our championships will have races. Special note: Guards will have a pit stop race, GTSCC are confirmed as one of the additional invitation races – more to be confirmed. Entry forms will be published in the next two weeks.

Spa, Belgium Friday-Sunday 21-23 May. Round Two of our HF2 championship. Entry forms due for publication within two weeks

Monza, Italy Friday-Sunday 4-6 June. Round Three of our HF2 championship.

Snetterton Saturday/Sunday 5-6 June. Autosport 3-hour race for Guards cars on Saturday. Pit stop races for HRS, 70's and Touring cars. Double headers for everybody else. Mallory Park Sunday 20 June. All our championships except Guards, Juniors and CRC. Possible double header for DBT and invitation race for FF2000.

## General

More details regarding race meetings will be included in future competitors' updates and in our bi-monthly magazine 'HSCC News'. For those of you with access to a computer please check our website regularly, but very briefly, the Brands Hatch Superprix will be on the Grand Prix circuit, we have two of our own races at the Silverstone Classic this year - for Road Sports and over 2 litre Touring cars. Only three of our championships will go to Castle Combe – Guards, 70's and HFF. We are all looking forward to returning to Croft, the Gold Cup will have a busy programme, HF2 are going to Nogaro in early September and as it is the single seaters' turn to race at Spa this year, we have booked a couple of races for closed wheel cars at Dijon in October – a new venture.

A reminder: You must all have working transponders (MSA regulation Q12.2.1) and up-dated competition picture\_VIFs for your cars, HSCC or FIA papers, and please enter races in good time.
