E-type Challenge Series Technical Regulations 2012



1.1 INTRODUCTION:

The following technical regulations are set out in accordance with the MSA specified format and it should be clearly understood that if the following texts do not clearly specify that you can do it you should work on the principle that you cannot.

1.2 GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The E-type Challenge is open to Jaguar E-type cars complying in full with the provisions of FIA Appendix K, in respect of Standard Grand Touring cars (GT), Competition Grand Touring cars (GTS). Each vehicle must possess FIA HTP and a Jaguar Heritage Production Record Trace Certificate.

Class Structure:

Class A. For Pre 66 specification cars complying with Homologation 100 or 34 (FIA Class GTS12)

(Class A will be subdivided into A1 for cars with aluminium or steel monocoques and Class A2 for cars with steel monocoques on the proviso there are suitable numbers to enable a split.)

Class B. For Pre 62 specification cars complying with Homologation 34 (FIA Class GTS7)

Unless specified elsewhere in these regulations all cars must conform entirely to the relevant specifications of FIA Appendix K and their HTP. Final authority in regard to the acceptance and classification of all cars will rest with the series Eligibility Scrutineer, and or co-ordinator who shall:-

- i) accept, reject or reclassify any car, and
- ii) determine the extent to which such acceptance, rejection or reclassification shall take effect retrospectively.

1.3 SAFETY REQUIREMENTS:

Vehicles must meet the higher of the minimum safety standards specified in FIA Appendix K or MSA Blue Book Section K (except (K4),(K6), (K7) and (K12.) which are not mandatory).

1.4 GENERAL TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS & EXCEPTIONS:

All vehicles must comply with their FIA HTP and with the technical requirements of FIA Appendix K except in respect of 1.6 and 1.7:-

1.5 BODYWORK: Minimum ground clearance for all cars will be 100mm as per FIA Appendix K Regs.

1.6 TYRES:

All Cars must use Dunlop L Section CR65 tread pattern tyres in 204 compound only.

1.7 WEIGHTS: The minimum weight for cars in Class A (Homologation 100) will be

Class A1 Cars with aluminium or steel monocoques 1000kg (except for original factory aluminium lightweight cars where the minimum will be 920kg)

Class A2 1100kg

The minimum weight for cars in Class B (Homologation 34) will be 1118kg

1.8 SILENCING:All vehicles must comply with MSA Regulation (J5.17) i.e. 105db and are also subject to individual circuit requirements if specified in Supplementary Regulations.

1(9) NUMBERS AND SERIES DECALS:

1(9).1 Positions

As per MSA Blue Book,Section J4 and Drawing 4 Individual sponsor's decals are limited to two per vehicle. All competing cars must display at least two HSCC badges one on each side of the car. If at any time the series has a sponsor – sponsors decals when provided must be displayed (one each side of car) failure to comply may result in a penalty being applied. Individual advertising as per MSA Regulations H28.1.1 – H28.1.6

1.10 Data Logging/Radio Equipment

No electronic data logging or radio communication between driver and pit is allowed on the car. The presence of such equipment, WHETHER IN USE OR NOT, will be deemed in contravention of the rules and the event organizers may apply penalties.
